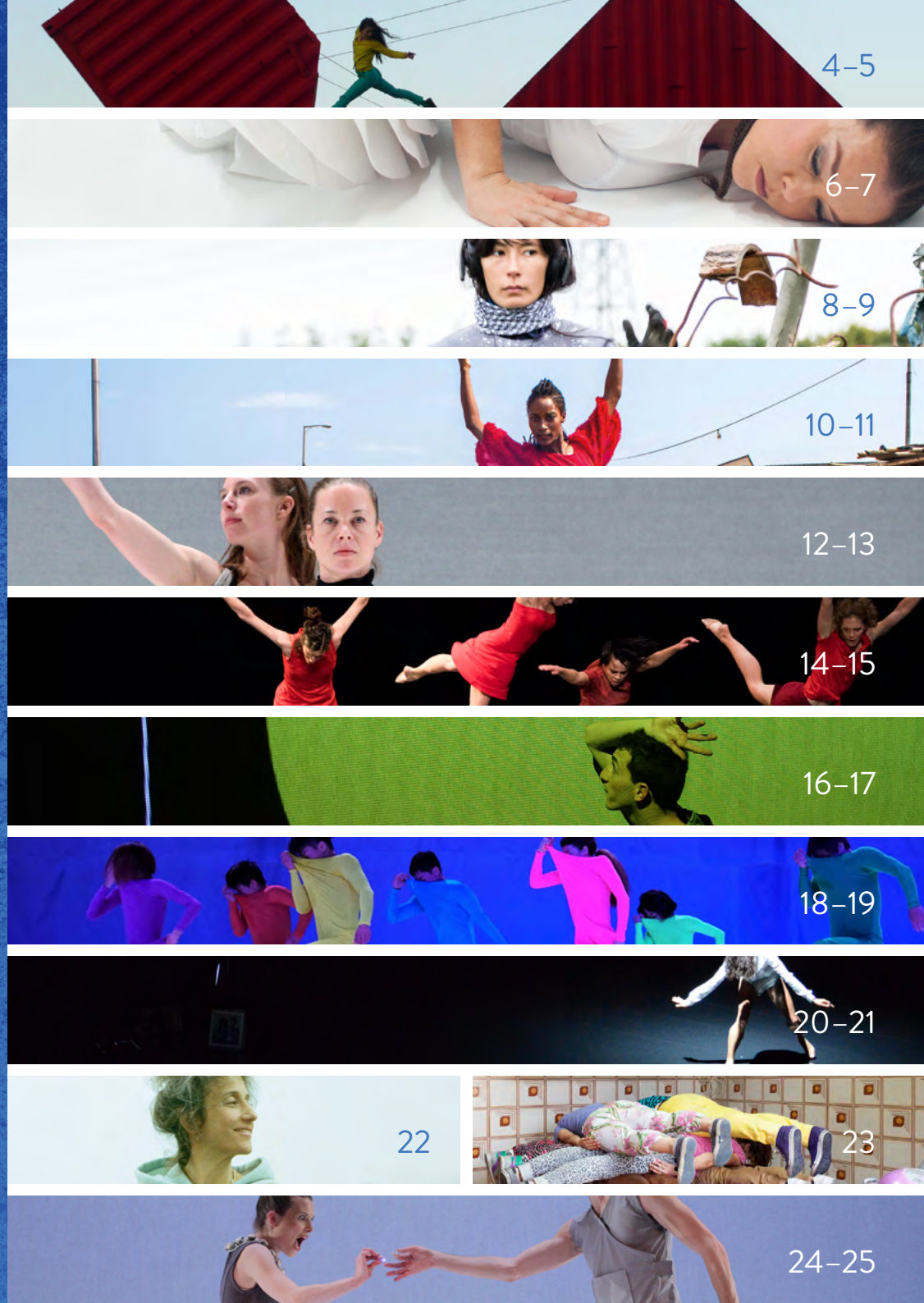

# SATCHIE NORO & SILVAIN OHL

## ORIGAMI

*Origami* sees the unlikely pairing of a monumental shipping container and a gravity-defying dancer.

Inspired by the Japanese art of paper folding, this 40 minute, free performance is a breath-holding spectacle where the container gently unfurls, creating a geometric performance space where dancer Satchie Noro dangles from its sharp corners and glides on its vertiginous edges. The container is in continuous movement, oblivious to the mesmerising duet that it is part of.

Created by Paris-based Satchie Noro and Silvain Ohl and with music by Fred Costa, *Origami* is an outdoor event, suitable for everyone, which takes places in five locations along the Thames and beyond. Join us for a heavy-metal transformation of our cityscape.

# ROCÍO MOLINA

## FALLEN FROM HEAVEN (CAÍDA DEL CIELO)

Spanish dancer Rocío Molina is a force of nature. With just a bare stage and four musicians she strips flamenco down to its purest form: a passionate and exhilarating expression of freedom.

In her latest work *Fallen from Heaven (Caída del Cielo)*, Molina takes us on a personal journey through womanhood. With designs ranging from a virginal confection, to matador jackets, to some inventive uses of leather, the piece is at times intensely raw and at others extremely witty.

Molina's Olivier nominated *Bosque Ardora* was one of the hits of DU2014 and we are delighted to welcome her back. A study in concentration and technique, Molina's flamenco is physically exhausting and she is not afraid to show it.

# RACHID OURAMDANE

## TORDRE

After an epic opening of determinedly false starts a series of impassioned solos follows, yet nothing is quite what it seems.

Solid sculptures start to move, gentle spinning becomes a dangerous compulsion, and calm is interrupted. It is Annie Hanauer and Lora Juodkaite's distinctive physicalities that finally unite them in these raw and captivating self-portraits, threaded with emotion.

French Algerian Rachid Ouramdane is co-director of CCN2-Centre chorégraphique national de Grenoble. His work frequently blurs the lines between dance and documentary, between public performance and private contemplation – achieved here with a refreshing simplicity of means.

# EUN-ME AHN

## LET ME CHANGE YOUR NAME

Eun-Me Ahn is recognised as one of Asia's most irreverent yet sophisticated dance makers. *Let Me Change Your Name* embodies the wit and choreographic complexity of her work.

Moving from deep solemnity through to nonchalant exhibitionism and psychedelic abandon, nine dancers play with ideas of identity and androgyny helped by their interchangeable neon costumes. This surreal treat is set to a score of natural and composed sounds by Young-Gyu Jang.

Eun-Me Ahn was born and raised in Korea, and continued her training in New York. In recent years she has enjoyed Europe-wide success including multiple invitations to her friend Pina Bausch's Wuppertal Festival.

## Finding the Thread, Losing the Plot

Liz Lerman, Institute Professor at Herberger Institute for Design and the Arts, is well known as a choreographer, author, MacArthur 'Genius' Fellow, founder of Dance Exchange and creator of the popular Critical Response Process.

Launching the Dance Umbrella Lecture series, Lerman will consider the different ways we watch theatre and dance, and examine where we find strength and resonance as art-makers and art-watchers. Lerman takes real situations as starting points for her creations – the American Civil War, ageing, physics at CERN, microbiology – to travel far beyond reality, constructing performances that are personal, funny, and intellectually vivid.

Following the lecture there will be a Q&A with Steven Hoggett, Movement Director for *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time*.
